Transportation to shelters

Votran, Volusia County's public transportation service will provide free transportation to public shelters. All Votran bus stops are evacuation assembly points during a declared emergency evacuation order. If special needs evacuees cannot reach a regular stop, **they must call Votran to arrange transportation.**

Bus space is limited. Carry-on items are limited to a pillow, blanket and one carry-on-bag (not larger than 22' x 16' x 8').
